



Turbomachinery Maintenance is so critical that we needed two covers here, to highlight its importance!

Take a leading petrochemical refinery like this, and you have output anywhere between 140,000 and 200,000 barrels a day. Now consider that there are no fewer than 2000 pumps, as many as 120 compressors, and anywhere between 400 and 600 steam turbines and other rotating equipment, not to mention several 30-MW range gas turbines for cogeneration - all needing the professional and necessary overhaul, maintenance and repair that this industry has to offer.

The operation of turbomachinery is so vital, in many cases, consuming 60% of a facility's overall maintenance budget. All of this to insure equipment longevity, and extend the plant's operation time between shut-downs.
