The English for Academic Purposes Series has been designed to meet the needs of university, pre-university and upper secondary school students who have an intermediate knowledge of English. Each volume comprises a highly flexible course suitable for use in English as a Second Language, English as a Foreign Language or English for Special Purposes contexts. Little or no previous knowledge of the subject is assumed.

Each book contains 15 units, with progress checks after units 5 and 10. The text material is fully authentic and is taken from school and college textbooks on the particular subject. All units contain illustrations or diagrams. Emphasis is placed on scanning and reading for information; understanding is checked through a variety of exercises and activities; important lexical items are isolated for special attention and significant points of grammar are revised.

Listening tasks of several types are based on the recorded cassettes which accompany the books. All the information retrieval skills needed by students are thoroughly practised.

The series can be used by either native or non-native teachers of English, and by teachers who have no specialised knowledge of the subject area covered.

Each title consists of a Student's Book, a Teacher's Book and two Cassettes.
